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Chicagoland USBC Women's Championship 2010 Tournament Rules

Please read carefully!

1. All entrants in the Women's Championship Tournament must be members in good standing with the Chicagoland USBC Association holding a 2009 - 2010 membership card. She must show her USBC certification card and if applicable, her multiple certification card when checking in. Those who are eligible for another association's championship tournament are eligible to bowl provided they have at least 21 games at the time of participation in a league under the jurisdiction of the Chicagoland USBC Association.
2. Average for handicapping shall be submitted based on the highest average in the following order:
 - a) Highest USBC Association league average for the end of the previous winter season, based on 21 games or more;
 - b) If "a" does not apply, use the highest USBC Association league average as of the end of the previous summer season, based on 21 games or more;
 - c) If "a" or "b" do not apply, use the highest USBC Association league average as of, and including Sunday, January 3, 2010 based on 21 games or more;
 - d) If "a" or "b" or "c" do not apply, entrant shall use her highest USBC Association league average for 21 games or more as of the date of participation.
 - e) If at the time of participation an entrant has a current average for 21 or more games that is 10 pins or more higher than the prior season's average, the current average **MUST** be used.
 - f) Tournament management reserves right to rerate.

Failure to submit the correct average, or failure to make a correction prior to completing her first game bowled in the tournament, will disqualify the score if the submitted average results in the bowler receiving more handicap than that to which she is entitled. If the submitted average is higher than the correct average, the handicap and prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. Affidavit must be returned within the date specified or she will compete without the benefit of handicap.

3. The Chicagoland USBC Women's Association Championship Tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis; 90% of the difference of the highest USBC Association league average and 210 scratch.
 - a) Current PWBA touring members will be limited to two (2) per team; one (1) per doubles event.
4. Multiple entries will be permitted in the team event only.
 - a) On a five (5) woman team, not more than three (3) women on the same team may re-enter.
 - b) On a four (4) woman team, not more than two (2) women on the same team may re-enter. Two (2) women must be dropped and two (2) new ones picked up, in either event.
 - c) ***When a bowler competes more than once in either the five or four woman team event, her first appearance shall count toward her all events score.***
 - d) Bowlers may place only once with the same team, but may place again as stated in "4" above.
 - e) Make-up teams are allowed. Substitutes and women members from certified Chicagoland USBC Association leagues are eligible.
5. If a duly scheduled entrant is unable to bowl, the captain shall have the right to substitute a bowler. In the five woman team event, three substitutes will be allowed and in the four woman team event, two substitutes will be allowed. In the doubles event, one substitute will be allowed. A substitute, in any event, must take the place in the lineup of the bowler she is replacing. ***Lineup as submitted will not be changed. Bowlers are not permitted to rearrange partners.***
6. Captains and individual entrants must report to the tournament office at least thirty (30) minutes before they are scheduled to bowl, and at least one (1) hour before, if a substitution is to be made.
7. The All Events optional prize fee is \$3.00 per person and fee must accompany entry form. The \$3.00 fee may be paid only by those entered in all three events-team, doubles and singles. Paid all events are not transferable unless the substitute replaces original entrant in all three events and the transfer is made by the tournament office, prior to the time of the substitute's participation in any event.
8. One Hundred Percent (100%) of Prize Fees shall revert to the Prize Fund. ***No entry money will be refunded****. All prize money will be paid on handicap scores.
9. The 5-Woman team, doubles and singles having the highest scratch total pins shall be declared Tournament Champions. The bowler having the highest scratch nine (9) game total pins shall be declared All Events Champion.
10. Awards will be given to both scratch and handicap winners in Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events with the highest scratch and handicap scores. In case of a tie for first place, in handicap scores, duplicate awards will be given and first and second place prize money will be equally divided.
11. In case of a tie for first place scratch, in any event the teams or individuals shall play off the tie within seven (7) days after the close of the tournament. The date and place shall be set by the Tournament Committee. Three (3) games shall be bowled to determine the Championships.
12. In case of disability after a game has started, a qualified substitute will be permitted, if available, and the combined score shall count. This applies in the team and doubles events only.
13. Singles must be bowled immediately following the doubles.
14. Any player or team arriving late shall begin play and the score shall count beginning with the frame then being bowled.
15. ***To improve the pace of bowling, the bowler must be on deck when it is her turn. If there is an unreasonable delay, the tournament manager may assign a zero for that frame.***
16. Any protest affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be made within seven (7) days of participation and confirmed in writing to the tournament manager. Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament manager within 24 hours. The Tournament Committee shall have the power to hear and act on all protests arising from or under construction of the rules of the tournament and their decision shall be final. The Tournament Committee shall decide any questions not covered by these tournament rules.

Five minutes of practice will be allowed. Bowlers are requested to wear suitable attire when participating.
