



Chicagoland USBC Star of Tomorrow Award

The Chicagoland USBC Association Youth Committee offers scholarships each year to reward outstanding youth bowlers, provided they meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Candidates must be a USBC Member, in the Chicagoland Association.
- Candidates must be amateur as defined by the USBC.
- Candidates must not have bowled for money, or merchandise in accordance with USBC eligibility rule, 400.
- Candidates must be under the age of 20 as of August 1st.

Scholarships are awarded in the amount of \$100.⁰⁰. Two scholarship amounts awarded to certified USBC youth, one male bowler, and one female bowler. Money award will be placed in bowler's SMART fund, and is redeemed through the SMART scholarship fund. Judging will be based equally on scholastic ability, community involvement, and bowling accomplishments. Awards are non-renewable, you may only win once.

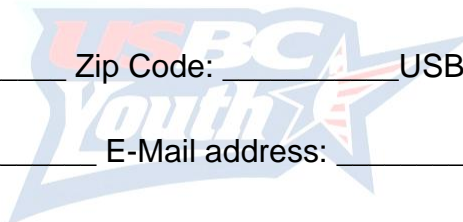
