TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **Eligibility** - Entrants must be a current member of USBC and proof of membership will be required. **This tournament will be conducted in accordance with USBC rules.**
2. Doubles will consist of (1) man and (1) woman. Bowlers may participate as many times as they like, but cash only once with the same partner.
3. This is a Pins Over Average event based on the combined average of the team.
4. Average shall be determined in the following order:
 - a) The highest current USBC certified league average for the 2009 – 2010 season, based on 21 or more games;
 - b) If “a” does not apply, entrant shall use his/her highest current USBC certified league average for 21 or more games, and provide a verified copy of the standing sheet where their highest average is held.
 - c) In accordance with Rule 319c, tournament management has the authority to adjust any entrant’s average upward (rerating) prior to participation. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded.
 - d) In accordance with Rule 319d, entrants who have qualified for cash/or merchandise of \$600 or more, within the last 12-month period must notify the tournament committee prior to participation.

NOTE: If entrants do not have an average meeting the above requirements, he/she must enter with a 210 average. Failure to use the correct average or failure to make a correction, prior to or at the time of bowling, will result in disqualification. If the submitted average is lower than his/her correct average the team will be disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than the correct average, winnings will be based on the submitted average. Affidavits must be returned within ten (10) days after participation, or you will compete with an average of 210.

5. Average corrections can be made up to the end of the first game of a series.
6. Entrants must check in with the tournament manager or his/her assistants, **AT LEAST THIRTY – MINUTES BEFORE** scheduled bowling time.
7. Walk-in registration will close 30 minutes prior to start of the squad in order to give the hosting house adequate time to enter the names and/or changes.
8. One hundred percent 100% of prize fees shall revert to the prize fund. NO entry money will be refunded. In the event of a tie, prize money will be equally divided. All prize money will be paid based on pins over average
9. In case of disability after a game has started, a qualified substitute will be permitted, if available, and the combined score shall count. A substitute shall bowl in the position of the original entrant he/she is replacing.
10. Tardy entrants must begin play with the score to count from the frame then being bowled, and not be credited with any pins for the frames missed. To insure the timely progress of the games, the bowler must be on deck when it is his/her turn. If there is an unreasonable delay, the bowler will receive zero for that frame.
11. In the event a team is unopposed on a pair of lanes, each frame shall be completed on one lane before the next frame is started on the adjoining lane.
12. Altering the surface of the ball once competition has started **WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.** Substances applied to the shoes which alter the surface of the approach are strictly forbidden, i.e. talcum powder, pumice, resin, aerosol products, etc.
13. Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament manager within 24 hours.
14. Cash ratio will be at least 1 out of 8.
15. Any questions arising not covered by the above rules will be referred to the Tournament Committee.
